Photographs of your work must be sent with application forms

Deadline for receipt of applications is Jan 31st 2021

Images of your work can be emailed or sent by disc but must accompany your application.

The first picture of your work will be used for the website. It must be a good representation of your work and of a high enough resolution (minimum 150dpi) to be clear when displayed on the website.

Images of work may be used for use in publicity material.

No money should be sent until spaces have been allocated and accepted by the potter.

Once a stall is allocated and accepted, payment can be made by online transfer or cheque.

Payment details will be sent with the offer of your stall.

If payment has not been received in full by the deadline date, the space will be given to the next potter on the waiting list.

Selection for Only Clay will take place during February 2021 with applicants informed in early March 2021.

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Only Clay Rules

Public Liability

The show has public liability insurance This does not cover individual stalls, Exhibitors must also have their own public liability insurance

Exhibitors will not be allowed to set up without proof of public liability insurance.

This can easily be obtained from AN (Artists Newsletter) www.a-n.co.uk

The maker must be present at all times and all the work displayed must be produced by the potter on the stand and whose name is on the application form.

Only Ceramic work can be sold at the show

Hence the show title 'ONLY CLAY'

Images

No application can be accepted without images of the work to be sold.

Please send 4 high quality images of your work at a minimum of 150dpi, each labeled with your name (e.g. S Booton 01)

Please send your images, with plenty of space around the pot so that they can be seen clearly and it will also allow cropping for web and advertising use.

Power

For anyone needing power there are a limited number of power points (at a nominal charge) in the venue and every attempt will be made to accommodate everyone's needs.

There will be a designated power point for the charging of phones etc. to avoid trailing leads Etc. H&S rules.

Payment in full is due on notification of being offered a space.

Potters who cancel cannot pass their space to a third party,

No sub-letting of space is allowed

Cancellation at any time after accepting a place will incur a £50 administration fee.

Cancellation after July 31st 2021 will result in the loss of all monies paid.

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Accomodation

Obviously due to its location and time of year on site camping / sleeping in vans is not allowed.

However there are a number of hotels within a short walk of the venue and I am in discussion with the local hotels regarding a discount for stall holders.

There is also a link, via the 'On the Doorstep' section of the website, that will highlight places to stay in the local area.

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Covid 19 plans and preparation

Although there is the promise of a vaccine available well before Only Clay 2021 takes place I feel it's important to plan for a show with some covid 19 restrictions in place.

With this in mind I have decided that although there is ample room for 60 stalls under "normal" circumstances, we are going to select 50 definite places at the show, with a covid reserve of 10 places that will be added to the show as soon as we know how the vaccine and its effects develop.

I know this is not perfect but with some shows for 2021 still being cancelled I feel a little flexibility and fluidity in the selection process is the best way forward.
